

REGULATIONS ON ORGANIZATION AND CONDUCTING INTERNATIONAL DISTANCE COMPETITION "CHILDREN'S GAMES OF THE TURKIC PEOPLES OF EURASIA"

Tolerant relations in society are the key to interethnic and interregional harmony, which was reflected in the implementation of the socially significant program of the Republic of Bashkortostan. In order to develop and improve interethnic relations, the competition "Children's Games of the Turkic peoples of Eurasia" are held. The game is an integral part of the spiritual culture of society, it contains almost all spheres of life of the ethnos: economy, material and spiritual culture. Through the activity, the younger generation acquires vital skills, learns the moral and ethical standards of the team, learns to win and overcome difficulties, and becomes familiar with the culture of its people.

Acquaintance with the games of different peoples allows us to better understand ourselves and see the unity and diversity of the cultures of the Turkic peoples of Eurasia.

1.1. This provision determines the conditions and procedure for holding the competition "Children's Games of the Turkic peoples of Eurasia"

- 1.2. The competition is organized within the framework of the project "International scientific and educational Internet platform" We are the Bashkirs ", the winner of the competition for the provision of subsidies to socially oriented non-profit organizations of the Republic of Bashkortostan for the implementation of socially significant programs in the direction of Strengthening interethnic and interreligious harmony "(based on the order of the Foundation for Assistance to Civil Society of the Republic of Belarus dated June 17, 2020, No. 32).
- 1.3. The organizer of the Competition is the Bashkir State Pedagogical University named after M. Akmulla ".
- 1.4. The general management of the preparation and conduct of the Competition are carried out by the organizing committee and the operational management is held by the working committee. The composition of the organizing committee and the working committee is formed from among the teaching staff of the Faculty of Bashkir Philology of the Bashkir State Pedagogical University named after M. Akmulla.
- 1.5 To sum up the results of the Competition, a competent jury is formed from among the leading scientists of the BSPU named after M. Akmulla, BSU, Institute of Nuclear Physics, UFIC RAS. The decision of the jury is drawn up in a protocol signed by the chairman of the jury and contains information about the winners of the Competition and competition works.

2. Goals and objectives of the Competition

- 2.1 The main goal of the Competition is to support and expand the ideas of young people and the older generation about the history and ethnography, folk culture and folklore of the Turkic peoples.
 - 2.2 The main objectives of the Competition:
 - popularization of folk culture;
 - popularization of children's and calendar games of the Turkic peoples;
- introducing the younger generation to the study and preservation of the game folklore of the Turkic peoples.
 - 2.3. The Contest is based on the following principles:
 - the principle of voluntariness: participation in the Competition is voluntary, at will;
- the principle of openness: anyone can take part in the Competition, regardless of age, education, social status, religion and citizenship;
- the principle of accessibility: participation in the Competition is free of charge, everyone is given the opportunity to participate in the Competition, the results are guaranteed on the page of the International scientific and educational Internet platform "We are Bashkirs" https://bez-bashkorttar.ru

3 Participation

- 3.1 Participants in the Competition can be residents of Russia and foreign countries, regardless of age, education, social status, religion and citizenship.
- 3.2 To participate in the Competition, you must send an application (Appendix No. 1) and competitive materials by April 10, 2021 to the email address of the organizing committee narod.igryBSPU@yandex.ru

4. Organization and deadlines of the Competition

- 4.1 The competition is held from February 1, 2021 to April 30, 2021.
- 4.2 The application and competition materials must be sent by April 10, 2021.
- 4.3 The competition materials evaluation time is from April 10, 2021 to April 20, 2021.
- 4.4 The competition materials will be posted on the "International scientific and educational Internet platform" We are Bashkirs" from April 20 to April 30, 2021. https://bez-bashkorttar.ru
 - 4.5 The results of the Contest will be announced on April 27.

5. Requirements for competitive materials and evaluation criteria

- 5.1 Competition work must be a completed project and consist of a detailed description of the game and the obligatory attachment to it, a presentation or video. The following folk games are described as examples: five pebbles, a string, alchiks or bones, a lark, hockey, hide and seek, blind man's buff (blind goat), a ring. Other games are also accepted.
- 5.2 The written part of the competitive work (description) must contain the following sections in the specified sequence: title page, which indicates the topic of the project, the surname and initials of the author who prepared the work, information about the co-authors and scientific supervisor of the work, location the author; the main section is the description of the game.
 - 5.3 The presentation contains photographs of all stages of the described game.
 - 5.4 The video must be a recording of the game being described.

- 5.5. Criteria for evaluating the materials of the Competition
- compliance with the goals and objectives of the Competition;
- the depth of the topic and clarity of presentation;
- the creative nature of the work, the independence of the approach to research;
- the presence of national flavor in photo and video materials, aesthetics of the work;
- the quality of the presentation of the material and the aesthetic design of the project;
- the quality of photos and videos.

6. Rewarding

- 6.1 The winners of the Competition will be awarded with diplomas of the BSPU named after M. Akmulla by age categories (10,-17 years old, 18 35 years old, 35 years old and older).
- 6.2. Academic supervisors of the winners of the Competition are awarded letters of thanks.
 - 6.3. All participants will be awarded with a certificate of participation.
- 6.4. The award material can be downloaded on the page of the International scientific and educational Internet platform "We are Bashkirs" https://bez-bashkorttar.ru *after April* 30, 2021.
