I. ABOUT NENU

Northeast Normal University(NENU) was founded in 1946. With more than 70 years of development, NENU has formed a distinctive characteristic of "Serving Basic Education" and is known as the "cradle of teachers". NENU is a key university, directly administered under the Ministry of Education's "211 Project" and "985 Project Innovation Platform for Dominant Disciplines". In 2017, NENU was selected as one of the "Double First-Class" universities.

NENU has two campuses (Renmin Street campus and Jingyue Street campus). There are over 15,000 undergraduates, 15,000 Master's and Ph.D Candidates and over 800 international students. NENU has more than 1700 full-time teachers, including 560 professors and 657 associate professors. The university comprises 21 schools, 72 undergraduate specialties, 35 M.A. programs of the first-level discipline, 25 M.A. master programs of professional degree, 24 Doctoral programs of the first-level discipline, 6 doctoral program of professional degree, 24 Post-doctoral Research Stations. NENU has six national "Double First-Class" construction disciplines: Marxist Theory, Education, World History, Chemistry, Statistics, and Materials Science and Engineering, and the number of selected disciplines ranks 19th in China. There are five national key disciplines: Ideological and Political Education, Principles of Education, World History, Cell Biology and Ecology. In the fourth round of discipline evaluation by the Ministry of Education, 6 disciplines were rated as A (including one A+) and 15 disciplines were rated as B.



NENU has established cooperation and exchange relations with more than 275 universities and research institutions in over 30 countries and regions, including the U.S., Canada, the UK, Australia, Korea, Japan and Russia, etc. NENU has established 6 Overseas Expertise Introduction Centers for Discipline Innovation("111 Project") and 4 Confucius Institutes, collaborated with Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey, to establish the

Rutgers University Newark Institute at NENU, and led 12 universities in China and Mongolia to establish the "Association of Universities of China and Mongolia". Overseas Chinese Affairs Office of the State Council of the People's Republic of China, the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs respectively set up "International Chinese Language Teacher Training Base", "Chinese Culture Education Base", "Education Aid Base" and "China-ASEAN Education Training Center" in NENU. Preparatory School for Chinese Students to Japan is also founded here.



II. COURSE DESCRIPTION

1. Comprehensive Chinese Course

Mainly focusing on training students' comprehensive abilities in listening, speaking, reading, and writing, integrated with relevant cultural knowledge and language communication skills for comprehensive training.

2. Spoken Chinese Course

Centered around practical themes from daily life, aiming to enhance students' language communication skills and cultural awareness through instruction and practice of conversational patterns and scenarios.

3. Chinese Practice Course

A specialized course providing students with language practice scenarios both inside and outside the classroom, including social surveys, field interviews, language competitions, and more.

4. Chinese Cultural Experience Course

Encompassing activities such as Chinese painting, hulusi (gourd flute), paper cutting, etc., aiming to achieve teaching goals through active engagement in learning, doing, and experiencing Chinese culture.

When students finish final test, they will be granted for the Certificate and 2 credits in *Immersion Course of Chinese Language and Culture*.

III FEES

- Tuition Fee: RMB 1600 Yuan
- Accommodation Fee: RMB 32 Yuan/day/person
- Insurance Fee: RMB 160 Yuan

Students have to afford transportation, meals and daily cost by themselves.

IV QUALIFICATION

- Students should be registered at home university as a full-time student.
- Students should hold HSK level3(or above) or sophomore or above majoring in Chinese Language.
- Students should obey Chinese laws, respect Chinese culture and follow NENU regulations.

After the approval of NENU, students will be notified via email to log into the studyatnenu.nenu.edu.cn, where they can view and download the electronic version of the admission notice.

Obtain the DQ Form

Students will receive an email titled [Notification on Your Information Form for Foreign Students' Short-term Visit Download]. Follow the instructions in the email to log in to the Study in China official website and download the DQ Form and apply for an X2 visa for entry.

XI ABOUT CHANGCHUN

Changchun City, also known as "Chang", is regarded as "the Spring City in the North" of China. It is the capital city of Jilin province. And it's considered a core city in the Harbin-Changchun city cluster. In addition, it is one of the central cities in Northeast China and an important industrial base designated by the State Council. As of 2022, Changchun City has a total area of 24,592 square kilometers and a population of 9.0872 million people, including 6.0727 million in urban areas. The city is divided into 7 districts and 1 county and governs 3 county-level cities.

Changchun has become a multi-functional modern city with numerous reputations such as the "Automotive Capital", the "Hollywood of China", the "City of Organic Food", the "City of Forests", the "City of Science and Education", and the "City of Sculptures". Changchun has won countless awards such as 2011 Top Ten Carbon City and the 2012 National Cultural City Award. It is also the first to receive the National Innovative City Award and voted for the City with Most Happiness and the City Provides Happiness for its Citizens by the national media and press.

Changchun is a city that has created an amazing place where civilization and nature mingle perfectly by merging urban and ecological elements. Dozens of parks such as the South Lake Park, the Changchun City Zoo, and the Hundred Flowers Park, and ideally located throughout the city with each having its characteristics. 36.5 % of the city has been presented with greening projects, 41.5 % of the land is covered with plants, and the index of

parks and green space is over 11.6 square meters per capita, all of which are above the national average.

Changchun is also known as the "City of Exhibitions". Changchun annually hosts as many as 200 different exhibitions, about one in 1.5 days translates to a celebration every day, with main exhibitions such as the Northeast Asia Investment and Trade Exposition(NAITE), the China Changchun International Auto Exposition, China Changchun International Agriculture Food Trade Fair(CCIAFTF).

The winter in Changchun is just cold enough to have powdery snow and just long enough to let people enjoy miles of icy and snowy sceneries. It also lets people enjoy the winter activities such as skiing, snowball fighting, or just chilling outdoors. These have become the signature of winter tourism.
